Coaching Certification Cards

Each time a coach completes a step or component of the NCCP, they should receive a wallet sized record card confirming the qualifications they have achieved in that program. As you may know, coaches that have completed components in the new NCCP Community Coaching program did not receive their cards right away. In order to provide cards for the new program, the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC) had to reprogram their database system, and that was not due to be completed until Christmas. Coaches waiting for their cards should receive them soon.

Coaches can access their own NCCP transcript on the CAC website at: <http://coach.ca>. To access this information, the coach should click on the link to "Check Certification status", enter their CC# and their last name. Coaches that do not know their CC# can request it via database@coach.ca
