Sovereign Lake Nordic Club – Tails on Trails Skijor Event – March 28th, 2026

HEALTH POLICY:	Sovereign Lake Nordic Club follows the mandates and recommendation of the Provincial Health Authority and Interior Health. We recommend that athletes and support staff reduce time spent in indoor spaces, wear a mask if you are experiencing any flu-like symptoms, are immunocompromised, or feel more comfortable doing so.
EVENT SCHEDULE	3:30 pm – Warm Up Area Open 4:00 pm – First Team Departs from Stadium 4:50 pm – Approximate Start of Last Team 5:30 – Estimated Last Finisher 5:45 – Celebration/Awards
FORMAT	<p>Teams consist of one person and one pooch. There will be two starting groups with a small break between the groups.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Just Dog It (for those that are new to the sport and just want to go out there and have fun with their pooch) - Breath Hard (for those that want to work as a team to bring it across the finish line as quickly as possible) <p>All teams will start at 2-minute intervals with the first team leaving at 4:00pm.</p>
REGISTRATION	<p>LIMIT OF 35 FOR REGISTRATION – ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS</p> <p>Entry cost is \$30, (does not include trail pass).</p> <p>Seeding (when you start) will be done after registration closes and the start list will be sent to the participants prior to the event. Registration will close in the week ahead of the event or when the event is full, whichever is first.</p>
REFUND POLICY	There will be no refunds provided.
EVENT DAY CHECK-IN	All teams must come to Event Day Registration to get final instructions, numbers, and start time.
PARKING	We ask that all teams park in the lower parking lot.
WASHROOM FACILITIES	<p>Humans: the lodge and outhouses.</p> <p>Pooches: Please get your humans to clean up after you as always. This includes during the event itself. If you have to go, then please stop and let others by while you take care of your business. And don't continue until it has been cleaned up and your human is carrying it with them (you know they love your little gifts!)</p>
COURSE	<p>See course map. The course will generally go out Passmore, to Upper Carl Wylie and then back on Woodland Bell.</p> <p>Warm up will be allowed on Howie's Loop and the lower trails. Do not use the regular trail system during the warm up. And in all cases pick up after your pooch. Help us be welcomed back to do this event again!</p>
SOME RULES	<p>It is important to all that everything remains safe for the participants, the dogs, SLNC members and the general public. We want this to be a success that leads to many more years, so please abide by the following rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dogs MUST be on leash at all times, from before exiting their vehicle until back in the vehicle. There will be a higher-than-normal concentration of dogs during the event so it is essential that all participants ensure that their dogs are under control at all times.

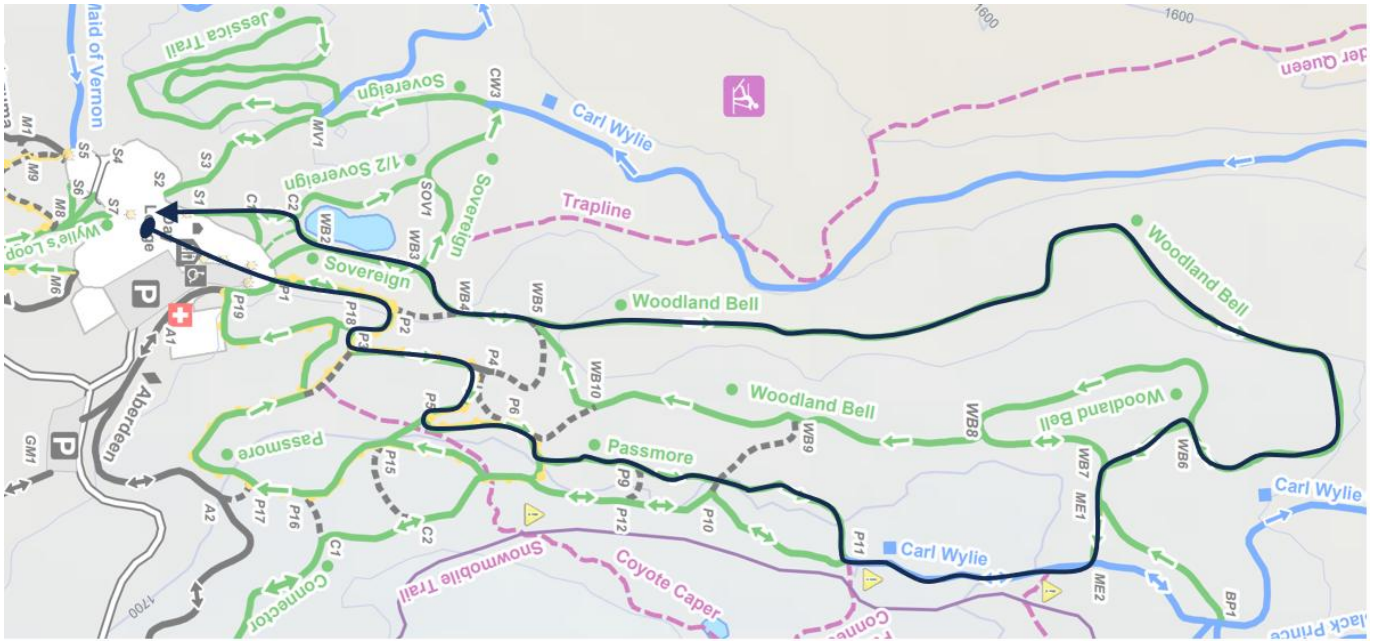
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - There is a "NO GREET" policy and that dogs must be kept on a leash and under handler's control at ALL times both in the parking lot and event area and handlers must ensure that dogs do NOT interact with other dogs or humans while attending the event. - Proper skijor equipment (i.e., proper Y harness, no retractable or hand-held leashes) must be used. - If it is obvious that a person/dog has no experience the team will not be permitted to participate. - If a dog displays inappropriate behaviour (i.e., fear, aggression, etc.) the team will not be permitted to participate. - Teams must clean up after themselves during the event. - The event organizers reserve the right to not permit a skijor team to participate if deemed to be a risk to the dog itself, other participants or member/general public or to disqualify and/or remove a team for not complying with any of the rules of the event. - If a team is removed or disqualified from the event, a refund will not be provided. - This event is not recommended for Brachycephalic breeds (French Bulldogs, Bulldogs, Boxers, Cavalier King Charles Spaniels, Shih Tzus, Boston Terriers, Mastiffs, and Pugs) – please check with your veterinarian before continuing with this registration.
ETIQUETTE ON THE TRAILS	<p>Just a reminder to everybody that this is a fun event and we want to encourage everybody to finish the event with a smile on their face and a wag in their tail. The trails are not closed for the event so there may be other users, so please stay aware of your surroundings. Some key points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If you're passing a slower team please make sure they are aware well in advance, by calling "Track". If you hear "Track" from behind please move over and have your dog under tight control while the other team overtakes you. - If you see somebody that is having medical trouble, please stop to assist and arrange for the next marshal down the trail to be informed so that support can be arranged. - Encourage others on the trail!
WAX POLICY	<p>Sovereign Lake Nordic Club requests that you do not use Fluoro Waxes. These aren't good for you or your pooch.</p>
TRAIL PASSES	<p>Trail passes are required to participate in the event. Either a seasons pass or a day pass is fine. This is not included in your entry fee. Please make sure to have your pass before coming to day of registration.</p> <p>Day Pass: online at Season Passes & Tickets – Sovereign Lake Nordic Club or at the ticket windows outside the day lodge, or purchase with your registration for a significantly reduced rate.</p>
FIRST AID	<p>We will have support for humans on site and on call coverage in Vernon for your dog. But please do not participate if the health of you or your partner may be compromised.</p>
